#### Payment information and deadlines

- Each new student should include a \$100 US deposit in order to complete his/her application. This deposit will apply to total fees.
- Students may make arrangements with the director to pay in installments at their convenience.
- A student wishing to participate in an Uno-a-Uno session should notify the director no less than one month prior to the desired start date. Any length of study is possible, and can usually be extended upon request. However, no refunds will be made once the session has started. Half of the fees are due as a deposit before arrangements will be made, and the balance will be due 30 days before the desired start date.
- No refunds will be made on Correspondence courses once the syllabus has been sent to the student.

- For new/returning students, a copy of your transcript is required, if one is not already on file.
