The appointment will include teaching and training responsibilities and may include program coordination within a 37.5 hour work week. In addition, major duties will include development of Solar Energy Technology courses plus curriculum and program development, academic advising, relevant committee service, student recruitment/retention and professional development activities related specifically to the duties of the position. The position is a renewable term appointment.

The successful candidate will possess enthusiasm for developing our energy program(s) and will be provided opportunity for advanced training and education in areas of energy, conservation, sustainability and related fields. Attendance at conferences and workshops will be encouraged and accommodated.

Teaching assignments may include evenings, weekends, off-campus locations, on-line delivery methods, and credit and non-credit course offerings. Qualifications include a master's degree from a recognized, regionally accredited college or university or equivalent work experience. Knowledge and experience in HVAC/R, Heat Pumps, Solar PV and Hot Water Systems are a plus. A demonstration of teaching effectiveness is part of the on campus interview.
