

Adjunct (Part-time) Faculty Position Computer Science

WVU Parkersburg is a Community and Technical College located in Parkersburg, WV, with a branch campus in Ripley, WV. (We are not a branch of West Virginia University). We are dedicated to teaching and are accredited by the Higher Learning Commission to offer certificates, associate's and bachelor's degrees.

Adjunct faculty appointments are part-time temporary, non-benefits-eligible assignments for one semester in duration, with a teaching load not to exceed 9 credit hours.

Responsibilities

The instructional duties will be at the main campus in Parkersburg in Spring and Summer of 2025, but may also include the instruction of classes at the Innovation and Technology Campus in Vienna beginning in Fall of 2025. Teaching assignments may include evening, weekend, hybrid and/or totally on-line instruction.

Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in either Computer Science, Information Systems, Software Engineering or a similar degree from a recognized, regionally accredited college or university and at least 3 years of professional experience in the field
- OR a master's degree in either Computer Science, Information Systems, Software Engineering or a similar degree from a recognized, regionally accredited college or university.
- Alternatively, a master's degree with a minimum of 18 semester hours graduate credit in Computer Science, Information Systems, Software Engineering or a similar field.
- College-level teaching experience is preferred.
